Final Project Assignment (ESC)

TASK: Design a 4 lesson early childhood dance unit for your classroom.

Your final project should include:

An introductory paragraph to your dance unit describing:

- The Theme of Your Early Childhood Dance Unit (mention links to other subject areas if appropriate)

- Teaching Context (public school, Early Childhood Center, etc.)

- Length of dance experience (e.g. 30 minutes, once per week, for six weeks this will specifically and directly correspond to possibilities in your classroom.)
- Age Group and Class Size
- Materials needed (music, drum, books, resources, props, etc.)
- A sampling of related classroom curricular activities

<u>The rationale for your project (relevance to curriculum/standards, dance, age group, personal interest, etc.)</u>:

- An explanation of your teaching style and methods as well as classroom management strategies you will use with your students.

- Include goals of your dance unit. Students will know, understand and be able to:
- Include relevant connections to the PKFCC standards or other standards if applicable.
- An outline of your 4 to 6 class dance unit (can be longer if need be)
- Two complete lesson plan for undergrad credit or three for grad credit
- Include 1 example of how you will provide evidence of learning.
