

Theme Webbing

A structure such as the one below, is incredibly useful in the process of taking a larger theme, perhaps the theme of a Unit, and "webbing" out smaller, more specific and explicit ideas that relate to that theme. This is essential in the pursuit of narrowing the focus of a Unit of study to smaller sub-themes in dance lesson planning. Repeating this exercise a few times may be necessary in order to arrive at your chosen sub-theme from where you can then web out **action words** to make your **movement sentence**. Add spoking lines accordingly. Think BIG and small; exhaust all possibilities; have fun!
