

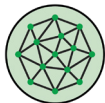

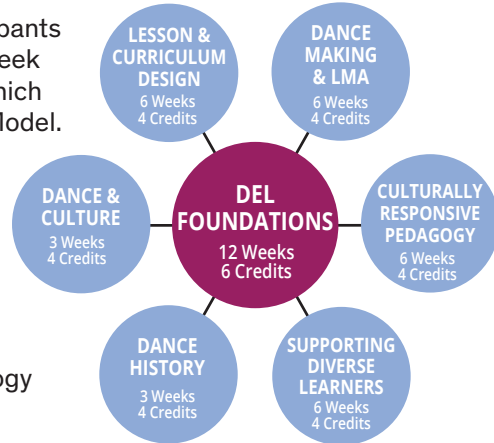

DEL INSTITUTE TEACHER CERTIFICATE CURRICULUM

DEL Foundations

All DEL Teacher Certificate participants are required to complete the 12-week online DEL Foundations course which provides an overview of the DEL Model.

Participants are also required to complete **six courses** in core content areas addressed in the DEL Model. These courses are either 6-week or 3-week courses:



- Dance Making & LMA
- Culturally Responsive Pedagogy in Dance Education
- Supporting Diverse Learners – *Dance & Students with Disabilities, OR, Dance in Early Childhood*
- Dance History – *DELving into Embodied Dance History*
- Dance & Culture – *Tracing Footsteps*
- Lesson & Curriculum Planning – *From Inspiration to Design*

Cohort Seminar

DEL Institute participants engage in six Cohort Seminar meetings held via Zoom (including Orientation and Graduation) designed to build community and deepen learning. DEL Facilitators visit the cohort seminar to share expertise in specialized topics related to dance and dance education.

1:1 Coaching

DEL Institute participants receive four one-on-one coaching sessions over the course of the program with DEL Institute Director, Ann Biddle. Cohort seminar and coaching sessions alternate months.

DEL Practicum + Final Project

The DEL Institute Teacher Certificate program culminates in a customized teaching practicum and final project scheduled for the Fall of 2024. Designed to enhance one's professional portfolio in the field of dance education, each participant will work under the guidance of a DEL Mentor teacher to design, implement, and document a curricular project with students.



DEL TEACHER CERTIFICATE PROGRAM 2023–2024

The DEL Teacher Certificate program combines DEL's diverse course offerings, individual coaching, and peer cohort model with a customized practicum experience. Participants complete a series of 7 consecutive online courses and engage in a final project to fulfill all certificate requirements. Participants are expected to complete course assignments within the time frame of each course, though have flexibility in terms of accessing course material each week. Students should expect 3 hours of work per week for 12- or 6-week courses and 6 hours for 3-week courses.

DEL Hybrid Pathway

DEL Facilitators in Training (DEL FIT Certificate)

The DEL FIT program is an intensive professional development training designed for experienced dance educators interested in learning how to design and facilitate professional learning workshops based on the DEL model. The immersive training consists of four Zoom sessions and four modules of asynchronous learning. DEL FIT is led by DEL Founder, Jody Arnhold, and DEL Institute Director, Ann Biddle. DEL FIT is scheduled for the Spring of 2024.

Earn College Credit

The Dance Education Laboratory (DEL), in conjunction with SUNY Empire State College (ESC), is able to offer undergraduate college credit for an additional fee. Supplemental college-level work can be incorporated into DEL's course content for students who wish to earn credits through ESC. In addition, these credits may satisfy New York City Department of Education teacher's salary differentials, New York State Education Department dance content requirements for dance licensure, and serve as prerequisites for college graduate dance education program admission.
