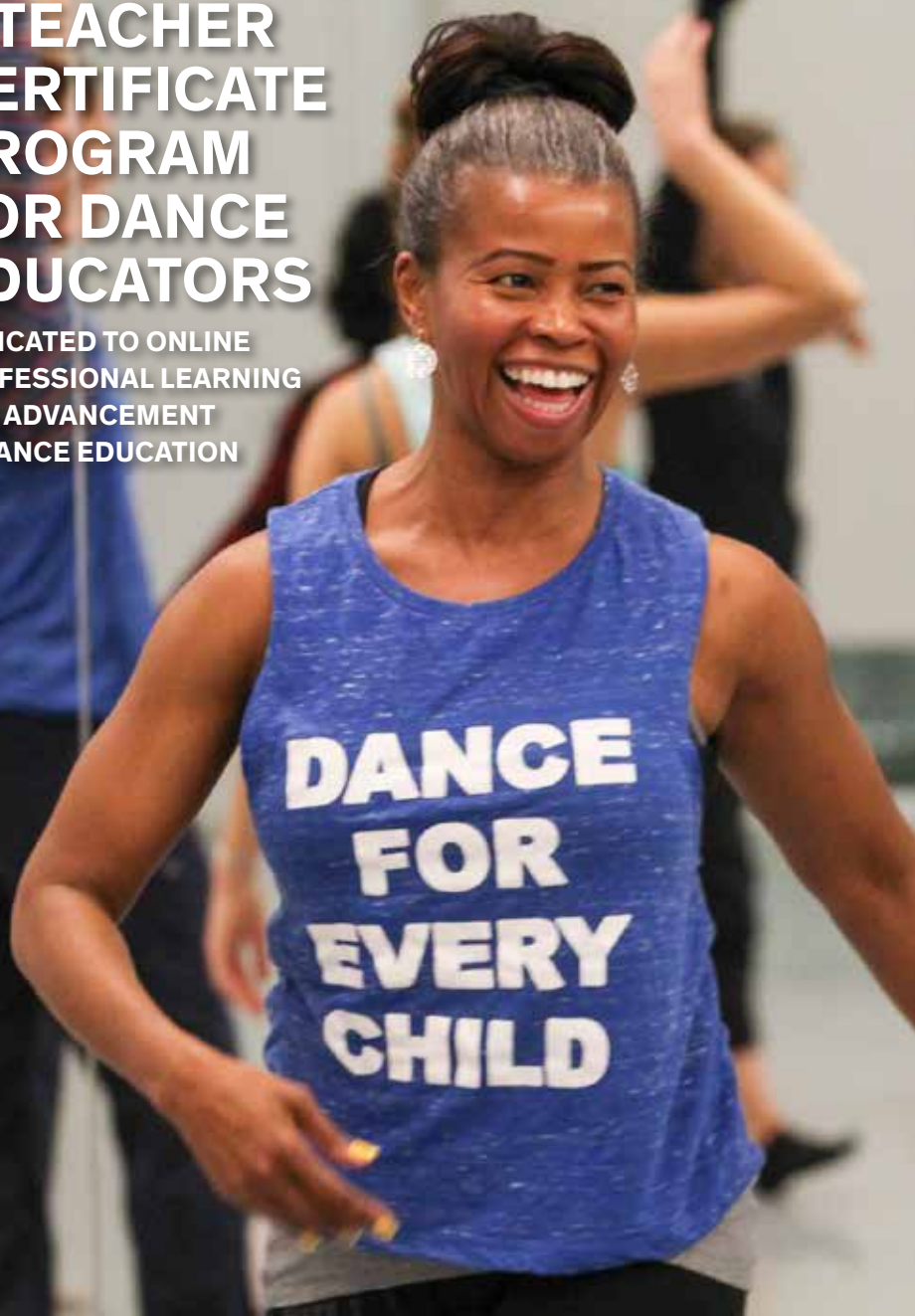

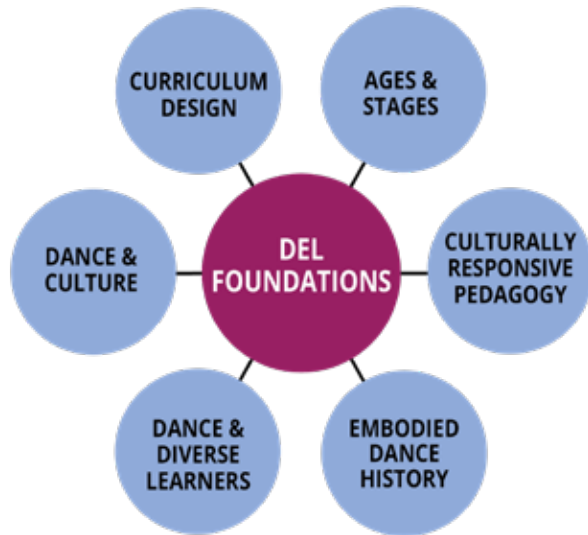

Required Courses

Cohort Seminar

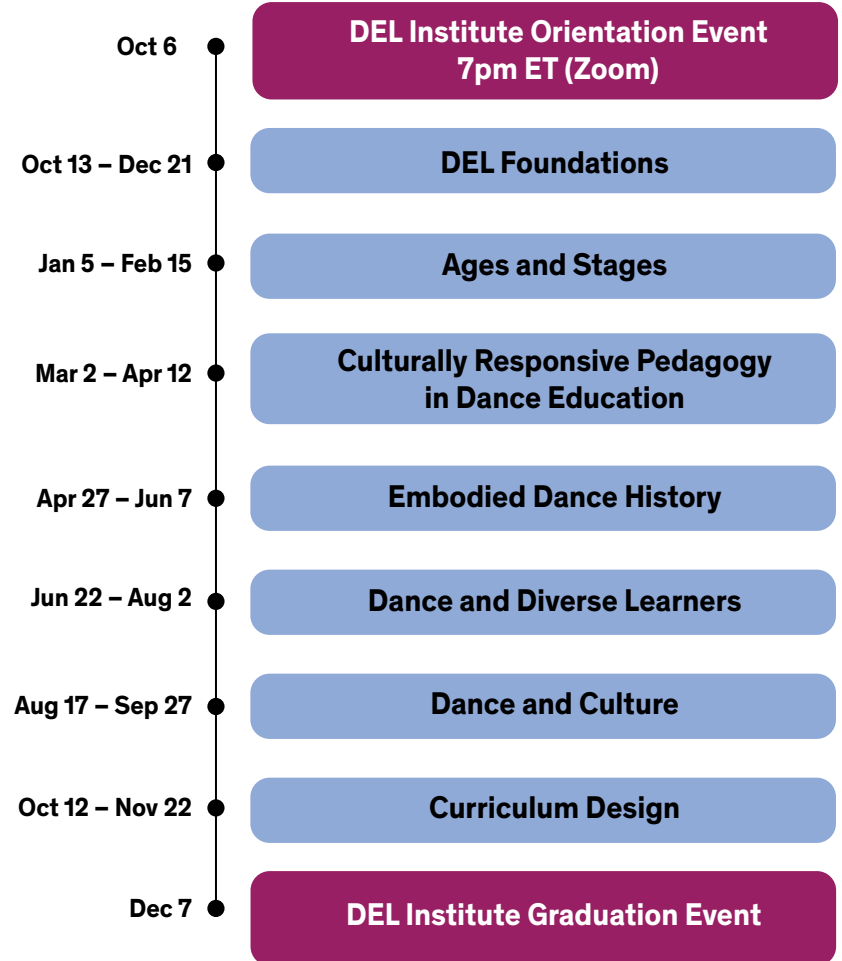
DEL Institute participants engage in six Cohort Seminar meetings held via Zoom (including Orientation and Graduation) designed to build community and deepen learning.

1:1 Coaching

DEL Institute participants receive five one-on-one coaching sessions throughout the program with Ann Biddle, DEL Professional Learning and Curriculum Senior Consultant.

DEL Curriculum Project

The DEL Institute program culminates with a final curriculum project designed to enhance one's professional portfolio in the field of dance education. Each student will work under the guidance of a DEL mentor to design, implement, and document a curricular project with students.



Cohort Seminars: October (Orientation), January, April, June, September, December (Graduation)

One-on-One Coaching: November, February, May, August, November

Ages and Stages: Participants will select 1 of 3 course options.
